## Amendment 2

### **Insert the following sailing instruction**

- 4.4 In the event of heavy weather Flag Numeral 4 will be flown. Whilst flying races will be started as per sailing instruction 10.6, finished as per sailing instruction 12.2 and courses chosen as sailing instruction 8.3.

### **Sailing instruction 8.3 shall now read**

- 8.3 In the event of heavy weather flag Numeral 4 will be flown from the flagstaff on the south east corner of the Brighton Marina Yacht club the course will be chosen from the following list of Buoys
- 1 Rigging N50° 48.06' W00° 06.40'
  - 2 Chandlery N50° 47.64' W00° 08.40'
  - 3 Boat Sales N50° 46.60' W00° 07.00'
  - 4 Sail Loft N50° 47.20' W00° 05.20'
  - 5 Portobello N50° 46.70' W00° 02.12'

### **Insert the following sailing instruction**

- 8.4 If races are started as per sailing instruction 10.6 the course to be sailed will be announced via VHF radio no later that the warning signal for each class.

### **Insert the following instruction**

- 9.3 Marks 1,2,3,4 and 5 are fixed yellow navigation marks

### **Insert the following sailing instruction**

- 10.6 In the event of heavy weather flag Numeral 4 will be flown from the flagstaff on the south east corner of the Brighton Marina Yacht club the starts will be controlled from the Shore the starting line is defined as a transit of the two orange triangles on the West Breakwater with the BMYC No 1 spar buoy as the Outer Distance Mark (ODM) unless otherwise prescribed. If only one triangle is in place the start line shall be the line between the triangle and the No 1 buoy. If there is no ODM no yacht shall start from a position further than 500 metres from the end of the Breakwater.

### **Insert the following sailing instruction**

- 12.2 In the event of heavy weather flag Numeral 4 will be flown from the flagstaff on the south east corner of the Brighton Marina Yacht club the finish is controlled from the Shore the finishing line is between BMYC No 1 Buoy and the flagstaff on the breakwater unless otherwise prescribed.
